Custom outdoor assemblies can reduce field termination time but may increase upfront material costs. **Labor:** Crew rates for aerial fiber installation typically range from \$75 to \$180 per hour, with total labor hours depending on run length, terrain, and access. Overhead deployment is generally 20-40% cheaper than underground trenching, due to reduced excavation and equipment needs. **Permits and Coordination:** Costs vary by region. Urban areas may require permits, traffic control, and utility coordination, which can add to the total project cost. Rural installations usually have lower permitting and coordination expenses.

Factors Affecting Price

- **Cable Type:** Single-mode fiber is more expensive than multimode, and higher strand counts increase material costs.
