

# How to make network cable tray cabling look neat



## Article Overview

Organize network cables by bundling, labeling, and routing them through trays or raceways to achieve a clean, professional appearance.

### Plan Your Layout

Start by mapping out your network devices and cable paths. Identify where cables will enter and exit the tray, and measure horizontal and vertical distances to avoid excess slack or tension. Consider the type of cabling (fiber or copper) and whether you are using end-of-row (EOR) or top-of-rack (TOR) configurations, as this will influence tray placement and routing options .

### Bundle and Secure Cables

Group similar cables together using Velcro straps or zip ties. Velcro is preferred for flexibility and easy adjustments, while zip ties provide a tighter hold. Avoid over-tightening to prevent cable damage. For longer runs, use spiral wraps or cable sashes to bundle multiple cables while still allowing access to individual lines .

### Use Cable Trays and Raceways

Install under-desk or overhead cable trays to keep cables off the floor and out of sight. Open-top trays allow easy access, while raceways or cord covers provide a more polished look and can be locked closed for aesthetics. Ensure cables exit the tray at appropriate points to minimize tangling and maintain accessibility .
