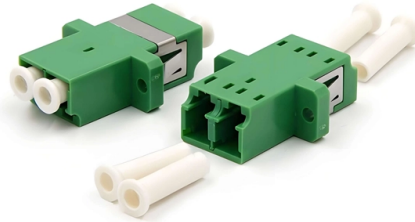


How to mount thick cables on cable trays



Article Overview

Installing thick cables in cable trays requires careful planning, proper tray selection, correct support spacing, and adherence to cable fill and bend radius standards to ensure safety and longevity.

1. Select the Appropriate Cable Tray

Choose a tray type that can support the weight and size of thick cables. Ladder trays are ideal for large-diameter power cables because their rungs provide strong support and allow ventilation to prevent heat buildup. Ventilated troughs can also be used if continuous support is needed, but ensure the tray material (steel, aluminum, or FRP) suits the environment, especially in corrosive or high-moisture areas .

2. Calculate Cable Fill and Tray Size

Thick cables occupy significant space, so do not exceed 40-50% of the tray's capacity. Calculate the total cross-sectional area of all cables and select a tray with sufficient width and depth to avoid overcrowding, which can cause overheating and reduce cable life .

3. Plan Support Spacing

Install tray supports at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, typically 1.5 to 3 meters. Shorter spacing (1.5 m) provides rigidity for heavy cables, while longer spacing (3 m) may require thicker tray material to prevent sagging. Ensure supports are level and aligned to maintain a straight cable path .

4. Maintain Proper Bend Radius
