

# How to power on a fiber optic terminal box



## Article Overview

To power on a fiber optic terminal box (ONT), ensure it is properly connected to a power source, check the outlet, and verify the device's power indicator lights.

### Steps to Power On

- **Locate the Terminal Box** Identify your fiber optic terminal box, often called an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). It is usually installed in your garage, basement, or near your home's main power box .
- **Check the Power Connection** Ensure the ONT is plugged into a working electrical outlet. If it uses a GFCI outlet, press the reset button to restore power if it has tripped .
- **Connect the Power Adapter** Use the power adapter provided with the ONT. Plug it securely into the device and the wall outlet. Confirm that the adapter is compatible with the device's voltage requirements.
- **Verify Power Indicator Lights** Most ONTs have LED indicators showing power status. A solid or blinking light typically indicates the device is receiving power. If no lights appear, try a different outlet or check the adapter for damage .
- **Restart the Device if Needed** If the ONT does not power on immediately, unplug it for 10-15 seconds and plug it back in. This can reset the device and resolve minor power issues .
