Personal Protective Measures

Work Area and Equipment

- Create a static-safe work area by covering benches and floors with grounded conductive materials . Remove non-conductive items such as plastics, nylon, or styrofoam.
- Ensure all equipment is properly grounded to prevent static transfer to optical modules . Avoid operating modules while powered during handling.
- Use anti-static packaging for storage and transportation, such as blister boxes or conductive bags .
