

How to reserve circuits in the distribution box

Key Steps to Reserve Circuits

1. Choose a Generously Sized Distribution Board Select a board with extra slots or modules beyond your current needs. Modern boards from brands like ABB or Hager often allow for 6 or more additional circuits, ensuring future appliances can be added without major renovations .
2. Leave Free Modules and Space Keep some DIN rail slots empty for future breakers. This allows you to add circuits for high-current devices like EV chargers, induction cooktops, or heat pumps without overloading the board .
3. Pre-Install or Prepare Wiring Run conduits and cable ducts to key locations in your home or building. Even if you don't connect devices immediately, having pre-laid wiring simplifies future installations and reduces labor costs .
4. Use Modular and Smart Installation Opt for modular boards with RCBOs or RCDs for each circuit. This setup improves safety, prevents nuisance tripping, and allows individual circuits to be added or upgraded easily .
5. Consider Residual Current Devices (RCDs) and Protection Ensure your board has adequate RCDs or RCBOs to protect new circuits. Separate lighting, power, and dedicated high-current circuits logically to maintain fault discrimination and safety .
6. Plan for Energy Distribution and Grid Capacity Check your main switch and overall power connection. If your grid connection is limited, you may need to request reinforcement from your utility provider to safely accommodate additional circuits .
