If the box is securely mounted to the wall from the outside and filled with silicone sealant or duct seal, it is acceptable. By sealing outdoor. No returns should have dampers. You can seal the electrical boxes with fire rated silicone caulk (not intumescent fire caulk). You can also use the orange great stuff foam, but I like the fire
