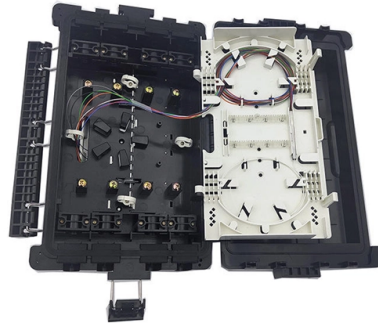


How to test for a tripped circuit breaker in a three-level distribution box



Article Overview

To test a tripped breaker, visually inspect its position, attempt a reset, and confirm power flow using a multimeter or non-contact voltage tester.

Safety First

Before testing, turn off all appliances and devices on the circuit to reduce load and prevent surges. Wear insulated gloves, safety glasses, and rubber-soled shoes. Never touch exposed wires or metal components inside the panel without proper precautions .

Step 1: Identify the Breaker

Open the distribution box and locate the breaker controlling the circuit in question. Breakers typically have three positions: ON (up), OFF (down), and TRIPPED (mid-position between ON and OFF), . A tripped breaker often sits slightly between ON and OFF.

Step 2: Attempt a Reset

Push the breaker firmly to the OFF position, then back to ON. If it stays ON, the breaker may be functioning normally. If it trips immediately, there may be a persistent fault in the circuit or the breaker itself may be faulty .
