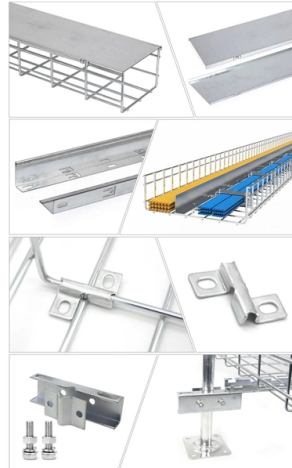


How to tighten a self-supporting optical cable for telecommunications



Overview

Most modern self-supporting cable clamps use a wedge mechanism. The messenger wire sits between two wedge-shaped jaws. Unlike traditional fiber cables that depend on messenger wires for support, ADSS cables are self-supporting, requiring clamps that. Low-voltage self-supporting cables (especially standard 6-core types), like any metal, expand and contract with temperature changes. In summer heat, conductor length increases and the “sag” increases. It incorporates both a steel messenger and the core of a standard optical fiber cable into a single jacket of figure-eight cross-section. The.
