

How to use cable trays and network cables

Connecting cable trays and network cables requires proper tray assembly, secure cable routing, grounding, and careful separation to ensure safety, performance, and maintainability.

Planning and Tray Installation

Start with careful planning of your cable tray layout, considering the location of network switches, servers, and electrical panels. Assess the types and quantity of cables, including future expansion needs, and calculate the load to select trays with adequate weight capacity . Choose the appropriate tray type—ladder, solid-bottom, perforated, or wire mesh—based on airflow, cable type, and environmental conditions . Mark the installation route and clean the area to remove debris before mounting trays .

Connecting Cable Trays

Secure tray sections using splice plates, bolted connections, quick-connect systems, or clamps. Splice plates are strong and reliable for straight runs, while quick-connect systems allow faster assembly with minimal tools . For angled or junction connections, use L, T, or cross-shaped plates. Ensure all tray sections are level, aligned, and firmly fastened to prevent sagging and maintain system stability .
