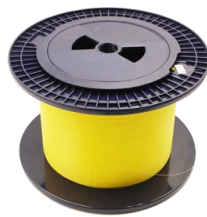

They offer high port density with GE, 10GE, 25GE, 40GE, and 100GE interfaces, supporting both Layer 2 and Layer 3 gateway functions. These switches are optimized for high-performance, scalable, and reliable networking, enabling simplified campus architectures and cloud-ready deployments .

Link Aggregation and Eth-Trunk

Huawei switches support Ethernet link aggregation, which combines multiple physical links into a single logical link (Eth-Trunk) to increase bandwidth, enhance reliability, and implement load balancing. Link aggregation can operate in:

- Manual mode: All member links actively forward traffic; suitable when the remote device does not support LACP. Requires identical interface type, rate, duplex, and flow control on both ends .
