Fiber optic cables can break during pulling if excessive tension is applied or if the cable is pulled by the outer jacket instead of the internal strength member.

Causes of Cable Breakage

Fiber optic cables are strong but delicate, with internal glass cores that transmit light. Most cables include kevlar or aramid yarn strength members that provide tensile strength, typically rated for 100–200 pounds or more depending on the cable type . Breakage often occurs when:

- The cable is pulled by the outer jacket rather than the internal strength member, causing the jacket to stretch, tear, or fail .
- Excessive pulling tension is applied beyond the cable's rated pull strength, which can happen if the puller's tension settings are too high or not monitored .
- The cable is bent beyond its minimum bend radius, especially older fiber types like OS1 or OM1, which are more prone to breakage .
- Improper use of pulling equipment, such as not using a pulling eye or protective sock, can concentrate stress on connectors or the cable body .
