- **Route Planning:** Align cable trays with the building structure, avoiding unnecessary crossings or detours. Maintain the shortest and straightest path to reduce cable loss and simplify maintenance .
- **Segregation:** Separate power and signal cables using dedicated trays to minimize electromagnetic interference .
- **Supports and Fastenings:** Use fire-rated brackets, hangers, and fasteners. Ensure proper spacing to prevent tray collapse and maintain safe evacuation routes .
