

Installation of the trip unit in the distribution box



Article Overview

Installing a trip unit involves safely mounting it in the circuit breaker, connecting the wiring according to specifications, and verifying proper operation before energizing the system.

Preparation and Safety

- **Power Off:** Ensure the distribution box is completely de-energized before starting any installation to prevent electric shock or equipment damage .
- **Verify Compatibility:** Confirm that the trip unit is compatible with the specific circuit breaker model (e.g., PD3, Compact NSX, EntelliGuard) and meets the required voltage and current ratings .
- **Gather Tools:** You will need insulated screwdrivers, torque wrenches, and any manufacturer-supplied mounting hardware.

Mounting the Trip Unit

- **Access the Circuit Breaker:** Open the distribution box and remove any protective covers to expose the breaker slot .
- **Align the Trip Unit:** Position the trip unit so that it aligns with the breaker's mounting guides or slots. For electronic trip units, ensure the connectors match the breaker interface .
- **Secure the Unit:** Insert the trip unit into the breaker and fasten it using the screws or clips provided. Ensure it is firmly seated to prevent movement during operation .
