

Installation steps for long-span cable trays



Article Overview

Long-span cable trays are installed using properly spaced supports, trapeze or swing hangers, and level cross members to ensure structural stability and safe cable management.

Planning and Design

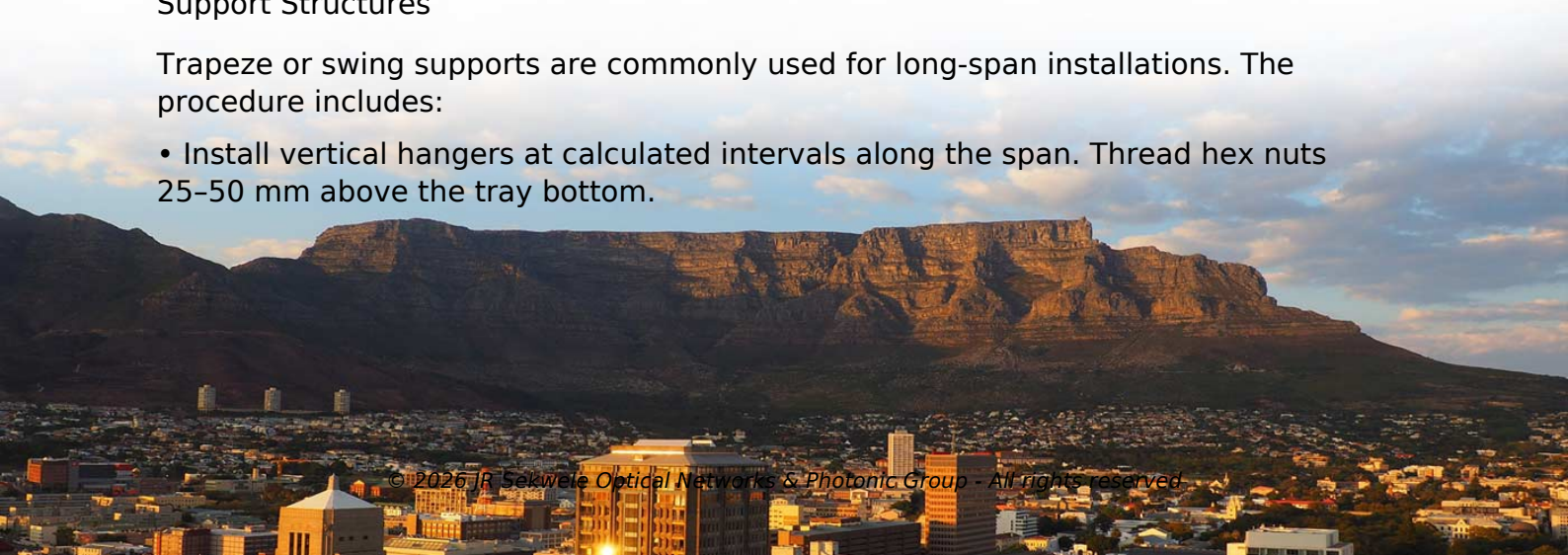
Before installation, a system designer or engineer should plan the layout, considering building codes, equipment specifications, clearances, and load requirements . The design must account for:

- Tray type and material (steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or galvanized) based on environmental conditions .
- Cable load and width to determine tray size and spacing .
- Support spacing for long spans, typically using trapeze or swing hangers .
- Thermal expansion and contraction allowances for long runs .

Support Structures

Trapeze or swing supports are commonly used for long-span installations. The procedure includes:

- Install vertical hangers at calculated intervals along the span. Thread hex nuts 25-50 mm above the tray bottom.
