Article Overview

No, Figure 5 depicts a high-density Cisco patch panel for 400G breakout connectivity, but it is not classified as a smart or intelligent patch panel.

Figure 5, as described in Cisco's documentation, shows a fiber optic patch panel enabling 400G breakout connectivity via LC ports connected to QSFP-100G modules. It is designed for high-density fiber management, providing tool-less access to connectors, efficient handling space, and support for SMF and MMF fiber deployments, but it does not include automated monitoring, tracking, or integration with network management software .

Difference Between Standard and Smart Patch Panels

Standard patch panels, like the one in Figure 5, primarily serve as a physical conduit for network cables, organizing connections and facilitating easy reconfiguration. They improve accessibility and reduce rack space but do not actively monitor or manage network activity . Smart or intelligent patch panels, such as SMARTPATCH or Belden PatchPro systems, include features like:

- Real-time monitoring of port connections and network changes
 - Automated tracking of moves, adds, and changes
 - Integration with IT service management tools
 - Alerts for unauthorized disconnections or faults
 - Support for both copper and fiber connectivity
- These features allow network administrators to proactively manage physical infrastructure, reduce downtime, and improve security, which standard panels like Figure 5 do not provide.
