

Is OFNP a requirement for outdoor optical cables



Overview

The NEC limits how far unlisted OSP optical-fiber cable can travel inside a building before it has to terminate or transition to a listed premises cable. The familiar number is 15 m (50 ft) from the point of entrance, but that allowance is conditional: the cable has to enter from outside, stay out. It decides where the cable can legally be installed, how it behaves in a fire, how long it survives outdoors, and how it holds up against oil, abrasion, and rodents. Quick overview: Fiber optic cable jackets are made from PVC, LSZH, PE, or TPU. OFNP is for plenum air-handling spaces; OFNR is for. These cables are designed to comply with ICEA-640, "Standard for Fiber Optic Outside Plant Communications Cables," in accordance with TIA/EIA-568-B. Vertical riser shaft (floor-to-floor backbone) - use OFNR or OFCR, or a higher-rated cable. This rule is essential in all NEC-based installations: OFNP cables can be used in both plenum and riser spaces, but OFNR cables cannot be used in plenum spaces.
