Fiber Count Classification

Fiber optic pigtails are categorized by the number of fibers they contain: single-core (one fiber), dual-core (two fibers), and multi-core (4, 12, or more fibers) . The most common pigtails used in telecommunications and data networks are single-core, which are easier to handle and splice in standard ODFs or terminal boxes . Dual-core pigtails are less common and are usually used in specialized applications requiring paired fibers for redundancy or duplex transmission .

Color Coding and Identification

The outer sheath color of a pigtail often indicates its fiber type or mode, not necessarily the fiber count. For example:

- Red outer sheath is sometimes used for single-mode fibers in certain manufacturer standards, but this can vary .
- Multimode fibers typically have orange or aqua sheaths, while single-mode fibers often have yellow or occasionally red, depending on the supplier . Because color coding is not universally standardized for fiber count, the red pigtail is most commonly single-core, but it is important to verify with the manufacturer or product datasheet to confirm whether it is single-core or dual-core.
