

Lebanon s fiber optic cable trench



Article Overview

Lebanon is actively deploying fiber optic networks through a multi-phase FTTX project, involving trenching and installation to improve internet speeds nationwide.

Overview of the FTTX Project

Lebanon's fiber optic initiative, launched in June 2018 by the Ministry of Telecommunications (MoT) and OGERO, aims to upgrade the country's broadband infrastructure using Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) and Fiber-to-the-Cabinet (FTTC) technologies, ensuring minimum internet speeds of 50 Mb/s . The project is divided into three phases, covering both urban and remote areas, with work distributed among three companies awarded the tender in February 2018 .

Trenching and Installation

The fiber optic deployment involves trenching for cable installation, connecting primary fiber lines to OGERO central offices and active street cabinets. This process replaces older copper networks with high-capacity optical fiber, capable of carrying significantly more data over long distances . Contractors are responsible for ensuring proper trenching, laying fiber cables, and connecting them to cabinets and premises, maintaining the required transmission speeds in FTTC locations.

Companies and Contractors

Several Lebanese companies are actively involved in the fiber optic infrastructure:

- Fiber Works & Communications (FWC) S.A.R.L. provides expertise in high-speed networks, supporting the FTTX project and handling system integration for public and enterprise projects .
