The load curve of a molded reinforced bottom cable tray shows the relationship between applied load and tray deflection, with safe working loads determined by span, material, and tray width.

Understanding Load Curves

A load curve represents how a cable tray deflects under increasing weight. For molded reinforced bottom trays, the curve is typically non-linear, with initial deflection being small under light loads and increasing more rapidly as the load approaches the tray's maximum rated capacity. The tray's reinforced molded bottom provides additional stiffness, allowing it to support heavier cables over longer spans compared to standard solid-bottom trays .

Key Factors Affecting the Load Curve

- **Span Length:** Longer spans increase deflection. Load tables usually assume the tray is continuous over four spans or more, with the end span considered the worst-case scenario .
- **Tray Width:** Wider trays experience additional local deflection across the base. This does not compromise structural integrity but may affect appearance or cable alignment .
- **Material and Reinforcement:** Molded reinforced trays are designed to resist bending and sagging. The reinforcement pattern and material (typically fiberglass or polymer composites) significantly influence the load curve .
