Fiber optic cables are classified primarily by transmission mode, core construction, and application, including single-mode, multimode, step-index, graded-index, loose-tube, and tight-buffered types.

Transmission Mode

Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)

- Features a very small core diameter (8–10 μm) allowing only one light path, minimizing signal dispersion.
- Ideal for long-distance, high-speed transmission, often used in telecom backbones and undersea cables.
- Subtypes include OS1 (tight-buffered, indoor use, up to 10 km) and OS2 (loose-tube, outdoor/long-haul, over 40 km) . Multimode Fiber (MMF)
- Has a larger core (50–62.5 μm) supporting multiple light paths simultaneously.
- Suitable for shorter distances, such as within buildings or campuses.
- Common multimode standards include OM1, OM2, OM3, and OM4, with OM3 and OM4 supporting 10G–100G speeds over distances up to 550 m .

Core Refractive Index Types

Step-Index Fiber

- Core has a uniform refractive index; light travels in straight paths, reflecting at the core-cladding boundary.
