

Method for connecting cable tray tees and elbows



Overview

The main cable tray connection methods include splice plates, bolted connections, quick connect systems, fish plates, clamps, and welding. When completely installed, without damage either to conductors or structural system use maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is erect the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
