

Methods for splicing fiber optic cables into pigtails

Fiber optic pigtails are spliced to trunk or distribution cables using either fusion or mechanical splicing, with careful preparation and protection to ensure low-loss, reliable connections.

Overview of Fiber Optic Pigtails

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare, exposed fiber on the other. The bare end is designed to be permanently spliced to an incoming fiber cable, providing a precise, low-loss connection while the connector end plugs into equipment, ODF ports, or splice trays. Pigtails are commonly used in single-mode (OS2) and multimode (OM3/OM4) networks, with connector types such as LC, SC, FC, ST, or APC depending on the application.

Splicing Methods

1. Fusion Splicing

Fusion splicing is the most reliable method for joining a pigtail to a fiber cable. It involves melting the fiber ends together using an electric arc. Key steps include:

- **Fiber Preparation:** Strip the protective coating from both the pigtail and the trunk fiber using specialized fiber strippers. Clean the bare glass with lint-free wipes and 99% isopropyl alcohol until it is free of debris.
- **Cleaving:** Use a high-precision cleaver to cut the fiber ends at a perfect 90-degree angle. This ensures a smooth, flat surface for fusion.
