

Moldova ONU Spectrum Splitter Parameters

ONU spectrum splitters in PON systems divide optical signals from an OLT to multiple ONUs using defined split ratios, wavelength filtering, and transmittance characteristics to optimize network performance and identification.

Split Ratios and Bandwidth Sharing

Optical splitters in PONs distribute a single optical signal from the OLT to multiple ONUs. Common split ratios include 1x2, 1x4, 1x8, 1x16, 1x32, and 1x64, with some networks using odd ratios like 1x3 or 1x5 to meet specific deployment needs. The split ratio determines how the bandwidth is shared among ONUs, but as long as the received power is sufficient, each ONU can operate effectively without degradation. Higher split ratios reduce the number of fibers required but increase insertion loss.

Wavelength Filtering and Transmittance

Advanced ONU spectrum splitters may include optical filtering structures in each light-out section. These filters allow identification of specific ONUs by wavelength or transmittance differences, enabling the OLT to detect which ONU is connected without scanning a wide wavelength range. Each light-out section can filter one or more wavelengths, and differences in transmittance or filtered wavelengths help distinguish multiple ONUs in the network.
