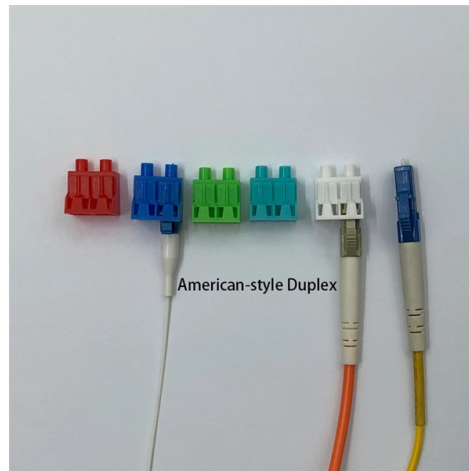

Overview

Honduras, a vibrant Central American nation, boasts a **population of ~10.6 million** (2024 estimates) with a **diverse racial and ethnic landscape**. Population estimates explicitly take into account the effects of excess mortality due to AIDS; this can result in lower life expectancy, higher infant mortality and death rates, lower. people have been internally displaced in Honduras as a result of generalized violence between 2004 and 2018. The majority identify as **Mestizo** (mixed Indigenous and European ancestry), followed by **Indigenous peoples** (Lenca, Garifuna, and others) and. According to the 2022 revision of the World Population Prospects the total population was 10,278,345 in 2021, compared to 1,487,000 in 1950 (a fivefold increase in 60 years). 9% were aged between 15 and 65 years of age, and.
