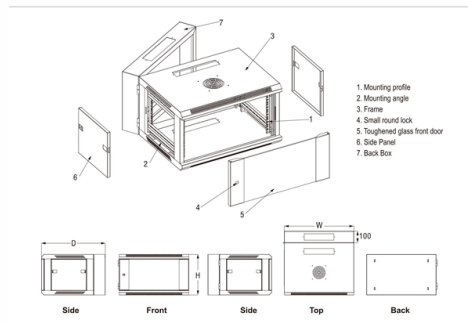


Network fiber optic cable on the utility pole
