The IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and BS 7671 (British Standard for Electrical Installations) both provide essential requirements for electrical installations, including those for fuse boards like garage unit, consumer unit and distribution board. The interfacing arrangement between CLP's and Developer / Customer's supply systems shall be agreed separately with CLP Regions. The summation metering system, if any, shall be agreed separately. Look for electrical wires, cables or equipment near where you are going to work and check for signs warning of dangers from electricity, or any other hazard. Remember to look up, down, and around you.
