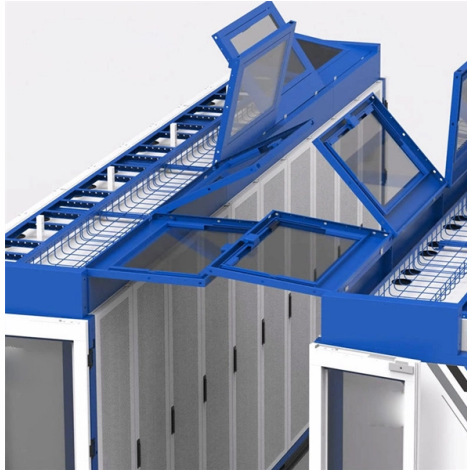


No response after connecting the fiber optic cable to the router

Fiber optic cables cannot connect directly to a standard router; an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is required to convert the optical signal into an Ethernet signal your router can use.

Understanding the Setup

Fiber optic internet uses light signals transmitted through the fiber cable. These signals must be converted into electrical signals before a router can interpret them. This conversion is performed by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which is typically provided and installed by your Internet Service Provider (ISP) near the point where the fiber enters your home . The ONT has:

- An optical input port for the fiber cable.
- An Ethernet output port to connect to your router's WAN or Internet port. Directly plugging a fiber cable into a standard router will not work because the router cannot process optical signals .

Correct Connection Steps

- Connect the fiber cable to the ONT: Remove protective caps and carefully insert the fiber connector into the ONT's optical port, ensuring it clicks securely .
- Link the ONT to the router: Use a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat6 or higher) from the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port .
