

Number of devices connected to the switch

A single network switch can typically connect anywhere from 4 to 128 devices, depending on its type and configuration, and the exact devices connected can be identified using commands or network management tools.

Maximum Device Capacity

The number of devices a switch can support depends on its type and port count. Common switches include:

- Unmanaged Switches: Basic connectivity, usually 4-24 ports.
- Managed Switches: Advanced features like VLANs, QoS, and SNMP, often supporting 32-128 devices in corporate environments .
- Smart Switches: Hybrid of managed and unmanaged, offering moderate management features. Factors affecting the number of devices include port speed, switch capacity (Gbps), and device bandwidth requirements . While technically more devices can be connected using splitters or additional switches, best practice is to match the number of devices to the switch's port capacity and network design.

Identifying Connected Devices

To determine which devices are currently connected to a switch, you can use several methods:

- Command-Line Interface (CLI) on Cisco Switches:
- `show mac-address-table`: Lists MAC addresses associated with each port.
