- Termination and protection for fiber splices and connectors.
- Organized routing of fiber cables with bend-radius compliance.
- Flexible cross-connection between incoming and outgoing fiber links.
- Easy maintenance and testing through accessible splice trays and modular adapter plates. ODFs integrate multiple functions, including fiber splicing, connector installation, optical path deployment, and storage of excess pigtails, all within a single unit . They are typically built to 19-inch rack standards and feature durable materials like cold-rolled steel or flame-retardant plastics for long-term reliability .

Fiber Optic Patch Cords

Fiber optic patch cords are short, pre-terminated fiber cables that connect active or passive network equipment to the patch panel . Key features include:

- Connector types: LC, SC, FC, ST, MPO/MTP, compatible with ODF adapter panels.
