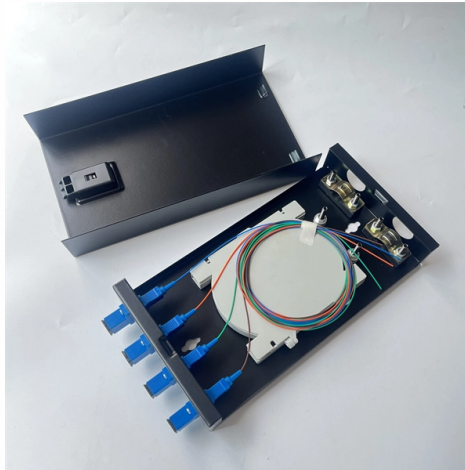

An OLT with a DML (Directly Modulated Laser) is a central device in a PON network that converts electrical signals into optical signals using a DML laser driver for high-speed data transmission.

Overview of OLT

An Optical Line Terminal (OLT) is the core device in a Passive Optical Network (PON), located at the service provider's central office. It connects the provider's backbone network to multiple customer endpoints via optical fibers and splitters, managing data transmission, bandwidth allocation, and network security while coordinating communication with Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Terminals (ONTs) at subscriber sites. OLTs support various PON standards, including GPON, XG-PON, XGS-PON, and 10G-EPON, and can handle split ratios from 1:32 up to 1:128 depending on the network design.

Role of DML in OLTs

A Directly Modulated Laser (DML) is a type of laser used in OLTs to convert electrical signals into optical signals for transmission over fiber. DMLs are modulated directly by the electrical input, making them suitable for high-speed PON applications. In GPON OLTs, combined DML driver modules, such as the GN25L99, integrate a 2.5 Gbps DML driver with a 1.25 Gbps burst mode limiting amplifier. This setup ensures reliable signal quality, dual-loop extinction ratio control, and eye-shaping for optimal optical performance. DMLs are widely used in GPON and XG/XGS combo-PON OLT modules to support gigabit and multi-gigabit services.
