

Optical cable tubing sequence



Overview

The standard defines a 12-color sequence that cycles through tubes and repeats for fibers within each tube, allowing unique identification of every fiber in cables up to 288 fibers and beyond. Standard cable construction groups 12 fibers into each buffer tube. Global Consistency: Whether cables originate in North America, Europe, or Asia, the same 12-color sequence applies—so any technician can interpret it correctly. * For cables >12 fibers: The sequence repeats with one or more black stripes (except black fibers, which receive yellow stripes) to. Prysmian uses the US industry standard repeating 12-color sequence. This identification scheme follows the TIA/EIA-598, “Optical Fiber Cable Color Coding. ” This standard is adopted by; Telcordia GR-20 – Generic Requirements for Optical Fiber and Optical.
