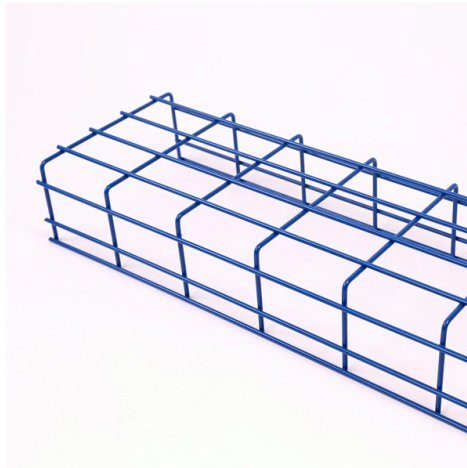


Optical module Ethernet port

An Ethernet optical port module is a modular transceiver that enables Ethernet data transmission over fiber optic or copper connections, supporting flexible speeds and distances.

Overview

Ethernet optical port modules, often implemented as SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) or SFP+ modules, are plug-in devices that allow switches, routers, or other network equipment to connect to fiber optic or copper cables for Ethernet communication. These modules are hot-swappable, meaning they can be inserted or removed without powering down the device, which enhances network flexibility and maintenance.

Types and Interfaces

- **SFP Modules:** Support Ethernet speeds up to 1 Gbit/s and are compatible with single-mode or multimode fiber using LC connectors.
- **SFP+ Modules:** Enhanced version supporting higher speeds, typically 10 Gbit/s, and used in high-speed Ethernet or Fiber Channel networks.
- **Electrical Port Modules:** Some optical ports can accept Ethernet port modules to connect copper cables via RJ45 interfaces, useful when fiber is unavailable. Common fiber connector types include LC, SC, and MPO, while copper connections use RJ45.
