Common Hot-Swappable Module Types

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Standard 1 Gbps modules, widely used in switches and routers .
- SFP+: Enhanced SFP supporting 10 Gbps, also hot-swappable .
- SFP28: Supports 25 Gbps, maintaining hot-swappable design principles .
- QSFP/QSFP+: 40 Gbps modules, designed for hot-plug operations in data centers .
- QSFP28: 100 Gbps modules, hot-swappable with proper host support .

How Hot-Swapping Works

Hot-swappable modules rely on mechanical and electrical design features:

- Gold finger connectors: Ensure ground-power-signal sequencing during insertion/removal, reducing the risk of data corruption .
- Hot-swap circuitry: Protects internal components from voltage or signal surges .
