Key Components and Their Placement

- **Main Switch:** Positioned at the top or easily accessible location to control the entire electrical supply. This allows quick disconnection in emergencies and simplifies maintenance .
- **Busbars:** Metal strips that distribute power from the main switch to individual circuit breakers. Place live, neutral, and earth busbars in parallel, ensuring clear separation to prevent accidental contact and short circuits .
- **Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Arrange breakers in rows below the main switch. Group them logically by function, such as lighting, outlets, kitchen appliances, and HVAC systems. Label each breaker clearly for easy identification .
- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs):** Install RCDs to protect against leakage currents and electric shocks, especially in wet areas like bathrooms and kitchens. They should be positioned upstream of the circuits they protect .
- **Neutral and Earth Links:** Place neutral and earth bars at the bottom or side of the box, ensuring all circuits are properly grounded. Maintain sufficient spacing for safe wiring connections .
