

Overlapping of cable trays and air ducts



Article Overview

Cable trays and air ducts should not overlap in a way that compromises airflow, cable safety, or compliance with electrical and HVAC standards.

Key Considerations

Cable trays are mechanical support systems designed to carry insulated electrical cables, allowing heat dissipation and easy maintenance, while air ducts transport conditioned or fresh air for HVAC systems . Overlapping or improper proximity can lead to several issues:

- **Heat Transfer:** Air ducts carrying hot or cold air can affect cable temperature. Excessive heat may degrade insulation, while cold ducts may cause condensation on cables .
- **Access and Maintenance:** Cable trays require open access for inspection and replacement. Overlapping ducts can obstruct this access, making maintenance difficult .
- **Fire Safety:** Cable trays in plenum or environmental air spaces must comply with strict standards. Only certain cable types, such as Type MI or Type MC with impervious metal sheaths, are permitted in ducts or plenums . Using standard cables in overlapping spaces can violate safety codes.
- **Mechanical Protection:** Ducts should not impose physical stress on cable trays. Ladder or ventilated trough trays are preferred for heavy or heat-generating cables, while solid bottom trays provide protection from debris but reduce ventilation .
