A pigtail connector is a short length of wire, cable, or optical fiber with a connector pre-installed on one end and a bare, stripped, or unterminated end on the other. The bare end is designed to be spliced, soldered, crimped, or fused to another conductor or fiber in the field. Pigtails simplify installation, reduce mechanical stress on main cables, and improve connection reliability in tight spaces or complex systems .

Types of Pigtail Connectors

1. Electrical Pigtails

- **Function:** Connect multiple wires to a single device terminal, such as outlets, switches, or fixtures. They prevent overcrowding and ensure a secure connection.
- **Construction:** Typically made of copper wire, stranded for flexibility, and insulated with PVC or cross-linked polyethylene.
- **Applications:** Automotive wiring (headlight sockets, fuel injector clips), home and commercial electrical systems, grounding connections .

2. Fiber Optic Pigtails

- **Function:** Facilitate the connection of optical fibers to network equipment by fusion-splicing the bare fiber end to a trunk fiber.
