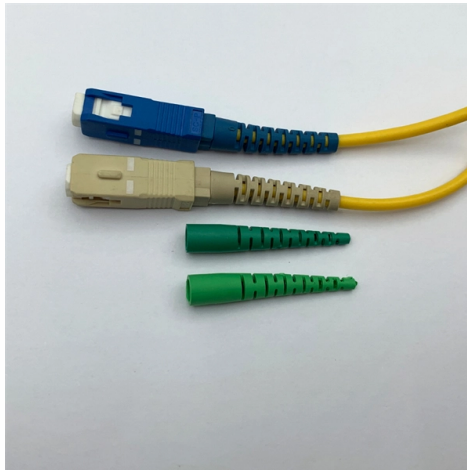


Pole-mounted fiber optic cable installation techniques
