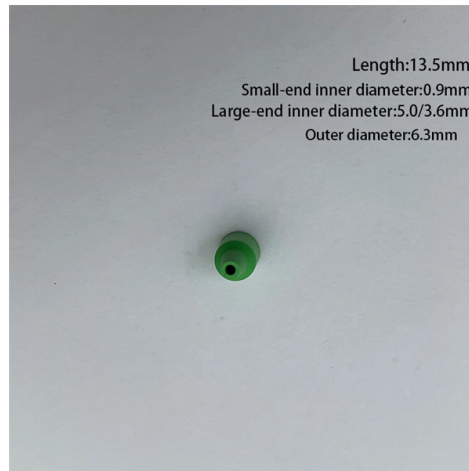


Power Distribution Box Ground Wire Color



Overview

The mandatory colors for power wiring in the National Electrical Code (NEC) are Green, Bare, or Green/Yellow (a yellow stripe or band on green) for the protective ground (PG), and White (or alternatively Gray) for the neutral wire. These are some beginner-friendly safety tips that you should remember before you touch any wire: ● Power Off All the Time: Switch off the breaker whenever working on any wires. It is the initial and the most significant step ● Test Before You Touch: A multimeter or a voltage tester can be used to.
