

Power consumption of KVM switch

KVM switches typically consume between 2-15 watts, depending on the model, number of ports, and whether external power is used.

Typical Power Usage

Most modern KVM switches are designed to be energy-efficient. For example, small dual-PC or 4-port desktop KVM switches often draw around 2-5 watts in standby or idle mode, while larger rack-mounted units with multiple ports can consume 10-15 watts or more when fully loaded with connected computers and peripherals . Power consumption is usually measured in watts for typical operation and BTU/h for fully loaded conditions .

External Power Requirements

Some KVM switches, especially those handling high-resolution video (e.g., 4K) or multiple USB devices, require an external power adapter to function reliably. For instance, a UGreen 4K HDMI KVM switch needs a 5V/2A DC adapter to maintain stable operation when connected to dual computers and peripherals . Without adequate power, users may experience screen flickering, mouse lag, or peripheral disconnects.

Factors Affecting Power Consumption

- Number of Ports: More connected computers increase the internal processing load, slightly raising power usage.
- Video Resolution: High-resolution video output (4K or higher) requires more power for signal processing.
