

Precautions before commissioning relay protection

Before commissioning relay protection, it is essential to verify installation, wiring, relay settings, and compliance with standards to ensure safe and reliable operation.

Key Precautions

1. Verify Installation and Wiring

- Check that all relays, current transformers (CTs), and voltage transformers (VTs) are installed correctly and securely. Incorrect wiring or installation can lead to nuisance tripping or failure to operate during faults .
- Remove all deliberate earth connections on wiring to prevent false trips during testing .
- Confirm polarity and magnetization curves of CTs to ensure correct operation . 2.

Conduct Pre-Commissioning Tests

- Perform type tests to ensure relays meet manufacturer specifications and relevant standards such as IEC 60255, IEEE C37.90, and IEC 61000 .
- Test individual relay functions, trip times, and characteristics under simulated fault conditions to verify performance .
- For numerical relays, check loopback communications and programmable logic to ensure proper signal transmission and correct settings . 3. Verify Relay Settings
- Enter and double-check relay settings manually or via software, ensuring a second person confirms accuracy .
