

Principle of a Secondary Distribution Box



Overview

The Secondary Distribution Box (SDB) receives power from Main Power Distribution box via an extender cable and provides a central power distribution to feed normal branch circuits to the electric floor modules through snap-on extender cables. A feeder usually begins with a feeder breaker at the distribution substation. Many feeders leave substation in a concrete ducts and are routed to a nearby pole.
