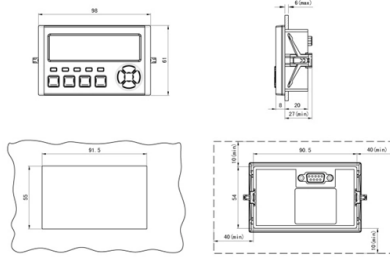


Purpose of Designing Optical Cables in South Sudan
