Safety Considerations

Open holes in distribution boxes or panelboards are direct pathways to energized components, posing risks of electrical shock, arc flash, and fire. Tools, wires, or conductive debris can accidentally contact live parts, while moisture or pests entering through unsealed knockouts can cause short circuits, corrosion, or repeated equipment failures . Always turn off power before performing any sealing work to ensure safety .

Material Selection

- Non-hardening electrical putty (duct seal compound): Pliable, non-toxic, and moldable around wires or knockouts; remains flexible for future adjustments .
- Fire-rated caulk or intumescent sealant: Used around box flanges or wall penetrations to maintain fire resistance and prevent smoke spread .
- Minimal-expansion, fire-rated foam: Fills larger voids or deep wall cavities without distorting the box or surrounding materials .
- Silicone sealant: Supports gaskets and cable entries, especially for outdoor or washdown enclosures; UV-resistant types are recommended for exterior use .
- Concrete, epoxy, or copper steel wool: For durable outdoor sealing around conduit or masonry penetrations .
