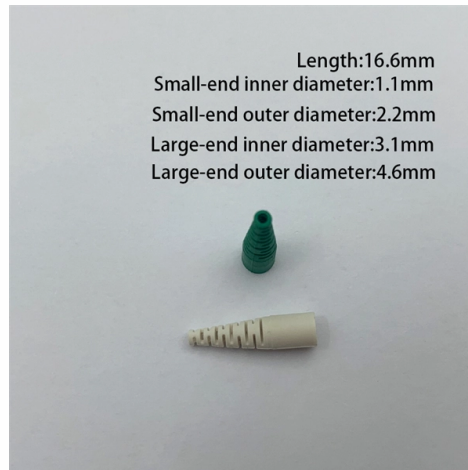


Quota for deploying butterfly-shaped optical cables

Fiber Count and Quota Considerations

Butterfly-shaped optical cables, also known as flat drop or FTTH cables, are designed for indoor wiring, last-mile deployment, and building entry solutions. The fiber count, which can be considered the "quota," usually ranges from 1 to 12 optical fibers per cable, depending on the application . For residential FTTH networks, 1-4 fibers are often sufficient, while commercial or campus networks may require 6-12 fibers to accommodate multiple users or future expansion .

Fiber Type and Performance

These cables typically use single-mode fibers, such as G.657A1 or G.657A2, which are bend-insensitive and optimized for tight indoor routing . This ensures minimal signal loss even in compact installations and allows for longer transmission distances without degradation . The choice of fiber type directly affects the effective quota, as higher-capacity fibers may reduce the number of physical strands needed.

Installation Environment

The recommended fiber quota also depends on the installation environment:

- Indoor-only projects: LSZH jackets are preferred for fire safety, and fewer fibers may suffice for individual apartments or offices .
