

# Ramp Bridge Construction



## Article Overview

A ramp bridge can be built by carefully planning slope, materials, and support structure to ensure safety, accessibility, and durability.

### Planning and Design

Start by measuring the rise and run of your ramp bridge. The rise is the vertical distance from the ground to the bridge deck, and the run is the horizontal length. For accessibility and ease of use, a gentle slope is recommended: a 1:12 ratio (1 inch of rise per 12 inches of run) is standard, while 1:16 or 1:20 slopes are easier to navigate but require more length. If the rise exceeds 30 inches, consider multiple ramp sections with level landings to maintain safety and comfort. Sketch a detailed plan including ramp width, landing size, and any turns or curves. For bridges, ensure the ramp is wide enough for intended traffic, whether pedestrian, wheelchair, or light vehicles.

### Materials and Tools

Common materials include:

- Pressure-treated wood for decking and supports, resistant to weather and decay
  - Metal sheets or aluminum for lightweight, durable ramps
  - Screws, bolts, and metal handles for secure assembly
- Essential tools include a miter saw, drill, level, framing nailer, and measuring tape. For larger spans, additional supports like beams or trusses may be required to ensure structural integrity.
