- **Fiber Strippers:** Remove the 250µm buffer coating without damaging the 125µm glass core. Spring-loaded, ergonomically designed strippers are recommended for all-day use, and triple-hole strippers are useful for multi-stage stripping .

Cleaning and Inspection Tools

- **Cleaning Kits:** Include lint-free wipes, cleaning fluid, fiber optic cleaning pens, and cleaning sticks to remove dust and contaminants from connector end faces and adapters .
- **Inspection Scopes:** Allow visual inspection of connector end faces to detect dirt, scratches, or defects before splicing or connecting .
