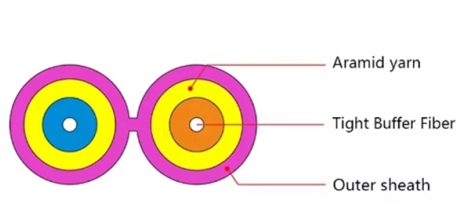


Remove 2 cores from 24-core optical cable



Article Overview

To remove 2 cores from a 24-core optical cable, carefully strip the outer sheath, separate the buffer tubes, and extract the desired fibers while protecting the remaining cores.

Step-by-Step Procedure

1. Gather Tools and Safety Equipment Ensure you have fiber optic strippers, precision cutters, needle-nose pliers, and eye protection. Fiber strands are sharp and can cause injury, so always wear safety glasses and handle fibers carefully . 2. Prepare the Cable

- Measure and mark the length of the outer sheath to be removed, typically 4-6 inches from the cable end for midspan or end access .
- Use a sheath knife to carefully ring-cut the outer jacket without damaging the ripcord, strength members, or inner buffer tubes .
- Flex the cable gently to separate and remove the outer sheath, exposing the inner core assembly. 3. Expose and Separate Buffer Tubes
- Identify the 24 color-coded buffer tubes or cores inside the cable .
- Remove any binder strings, water-blocking yarn, or flame barrier tape surrounding the tubes.
- Carefully unwrap the tubes one at a time, keeping the remaining fibers organized to prevent tangling or stress . 4. Isolate the Cores to Remove
