

Remove the fiber optic cable and then hang it on the pole



Article Overview

To safely remove and hang a fiber optic cable on a pole, proper planning, equipment, and adherence to aerial installation standards are essential.

Preparation and Safety

Before starting, survey the route and existing pole conditions to identify obstacles, clearance issues, and structural integrity of poles . Ensure all necessary permits and approvals are obtained if working on shared utility poles . Use personal protective equipment (PPE), including gloves, safety harnesses, and helmets, and follow all safety protocols for working at heights .

Removing the Existing Cable

- Inspect the cable and support strands for damage or tension issues .
- Detach the cable from hooks, clamps, or lashing while ensuring the cable is supported to prevent sudden drops or bending beyond its minimum bend radius .
- Remove any old support strands or temporary guy wires if necessary, taking care not to disturb other utilities on the pole .

Hanging the Cable on the Pole

- Install or verify support strands (messenger wires) to carry the cable load. These should be taut and anchored properly to withstand environmental stress .
- Attach the fiber optic cable to the support strand using hooks, clamps, or lashing methods depending on the cable type (self-supporting or hanging wire type) .
