Ensure all components, including circuit breakers, RCDs, and surge protection devices, are certified and correctly rated . 5. Installation Steps:

- Mount the Box: Securely fasten the new box to the wall, ensuring it is level and stable.
- Connect Main Supply: Carefully connect the main power line to the new box.
